

LCWSA New Multi-Family Development Process

Pre-Construction

- 1. Submit to LCWSA:
 - Service Availability Request Letter Review Fee: \$1,000 water/ \$1,000 sewer
 - Service Availability Request Letter
- 2. LCWSA returns (usually within 4-6 weeks):
 - Service Availability Letter
- 3. Submit to LCWSA:
 - Plan Review Fee: \$750 for water/ \$750 for sewer
 - Plans: 1 Hard Copy, 1 Digital
 - Letter stating the number and type of units
- 4. LCWSA returns:
 - Drawing comments (within 2 weeks)
 - Opinion of Cost/Quote Sheet with fees and current vault pricing
 - Vaults are purchased through LCWSA. Vault pricing is good for 10 days, request current price from LCWSA before purchasing.
 - Other documents as needed.
- 5. Return digital copy of plans with comments addressed.
- 6. LCWSA notifies engineer and signs signature block when construction plans and an extra cover sheet are brought to the LCWSA office

*Review is good for 1 year from date of signature

- 7. Submit to LCWSA
 - Signed Construction Plans: 1 Hard Copy, 1 Digital
 - Impact Fees: \$1,000 x sum of residential equivalents Residential equivalent:
 - 1. For 1 bedroom units: 200 gpd x # of units / (population factor x 100 gpd)
 - 2. For 2+ bedroom units/townhomes: 1 x # of units
 - Other Fees as required Meter and Backflow Vault costs; LCWSA installation cost; off-site fees; etc.

*Impact Fees and Construction Inspection Fees doubled if water and sewer are both through LCWSA
